Activities are designed to enhance the Newcomer's cross-cultural understanding, encourage community participation and integration.

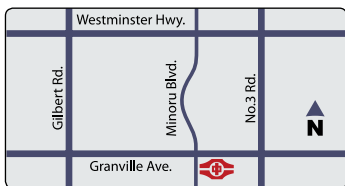

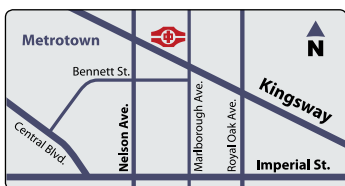
