Immigrant Trades Training Initiative (ITTI)

The Immigrant Trades Training Initiative (ITTI) is an Industry Training Authority (ITA) funded pilot project that assists immigrants in attaining recognized certification in the trades. The mission of ITTI is to inform, guide and support participants in choosing and accessing the appropriate resources and services to meet their goals.

In British Columbia there are over 130 regulated trades including: carpenters, electricians, plumbers and welders; as well as bakers, cooks, hairdressers and horticulturalists, etc.

Who will Benefit?

Are you:

- Permitted to live in Canada permanently?
- Interested in working in the trades?
- Unemployed and ineligible for Employment Insurance?
- Currently employed but lacking
 - *Local credentials, or*
 - *Full-time hours, or*
 - *Essential skills?*

We offer:

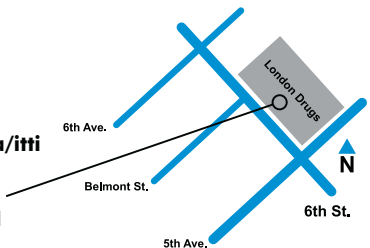
- **Free support** determining the right trade certification for you. We provide participants with information needed to decide whether to seek an **apprenticeship**, to seek additional **training** or to **challenge for certification**.
- Development of a **Trades Action Plan (TAP)** that includes:
 - Career exploration
 - English language skills
 - ITA trade route
 - The right survival job
 - Job search skills
 - Funding & resources
- **Long-term support and guidance** in utilizing effective strategies and accessing available resources.
- **Financial support** to overcome specific challenges such as transportation, child care, training costs etc.
