The Care Home is a licensed multi-level care facility with 103 beds. We provide professionally directed resident care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for residents who have complex care needs. Twenty-one beds are designated for special care for cognitively impaired residents requiring special environmental adaptation. Others are for complex care residents. We provide residents with full nutritional and food services and recreation programs. Medical services are also provided by individual Family Physician.

Adopting the philosophy of Eden Alternative, we are committed to build a human habitat so as to fight against the three plagues that threaten the well-being of elders in care home – loneliness, helplessness, and boredom.

Our residents are referred through the Provincial Continuing Care Program, which administers the wait list. Most of the rooms are private, with ensuite bathroom and nurse-call system. There are five semi-private (twin-bedded) rooms in the facility. There is no room differential rate.
